



**CAPE MAY CITY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL
PRESCHOOL/KINDERGARTEN
ENROLLMENT AND SCREENING
FOR 2010/2011**

Registration for the 2010/2011 Preschool and Kindergarten classes will take place at the Cape May City Elementary School, at 921 Lafayette Street, Cape May, during the week from 9:00 A.M. to 2:30 P.M. at the front office. Parents must pick up, complete, and return registration forms to the school office. Registration papers may also be accessed through our website at www.capemaycityschool.org.

2010/2011 Pre School will be a ½ day morning session from 8:20 A.M. until 11:00 A.M. and a ½ day PM session from 12:30 PM until 3:00 PM. Kindergarten will be a full day session from 8:20 A.M. until 3:00 P.M.

Preschool children must be four (4) years old on, or before, October 1, 2010, and kindergarten children must be five (5) years old before October 1, 2010. Please bring your child's birth certificate, immunization records, and proof of Cape May City residency.

As per Board of Education Policy, **Immunization Records** must be completed as follows prior to being admitted to school in September: (Information can be obtained from the school nurses website as well)

- 1) *Four (4) doses of DPT, including a booster, which cannot be closer than six (6) months following the last dose of the initial series.
- 2) *Three (3) Sabin Oral Polio immunizations, including a booster, which must not be closer than six (6) months following the last dose of the initial series.
- 3) *Two (2) MMR (Measles [Rubeola], German Measles [Rubella], and Mumps) immunization received after first (1st) birthday.
- 4) Three (3) doses Hep B (Hepatitis B)
- 5) One (1) dose Varicella or Proof of Chicken Pox disease
- 6) Pneumococcal (PCV7)
- 7) Influenza Vaccine (Preschool Only) – Between September & December
- 8) One (1) dose HIB (Preschool Only)
(*One (1) dose must be received after fourth (4th) birthday.)
